

Temporary Tattoos Art Preparation Guide

- Tattoo art should allow 3mm margin around each image and around the outside of the tattoo sheet. For example, a 38 x 38mm tattoo sheet will have a maximum imprint area of 32 x 32mm.
- Mandatory black imprint on the back of the tattoo includes ingredients list, country of origin & warning. Standard directions strongly recommended. Option of distributor details on the backing sheet – if company web address is not available, www.tattoosafety.net will be printed on the back of tattoo sheets us per USA regulations.
- Price includes 4CP Print, specify if white or clear background is required or if certain areas of design are to be printed white. If not specified, white areas may be left clear so that skin colour shows through when applied (or vice versa).
- Multiple images work best on larger tattoo sheets.
- Temporary tattoos are wrong reading when printed & right reading when applied.
- Tattoos are printed in 4 colour process and closely matched to PMS colours if required (please specify)
- Tip – Lighter & brighter ink colours are recommended as usually more durable on the skin. Solid dark colours are less durable and large reversal blocks of ink can break down quicker on the skin than other areas.
